Code of Conduct

- 1. Participants are required to be a registered member of the Boys & Girls Club of Victoria.
- 2. The Club phone is for business and employees only. A member may use the phone to call to be picked up (two minuet limit). Cell phones are not allowed.
- 3. No alcoholic beverages or tobacco products of any kind are allowed on the premises.
